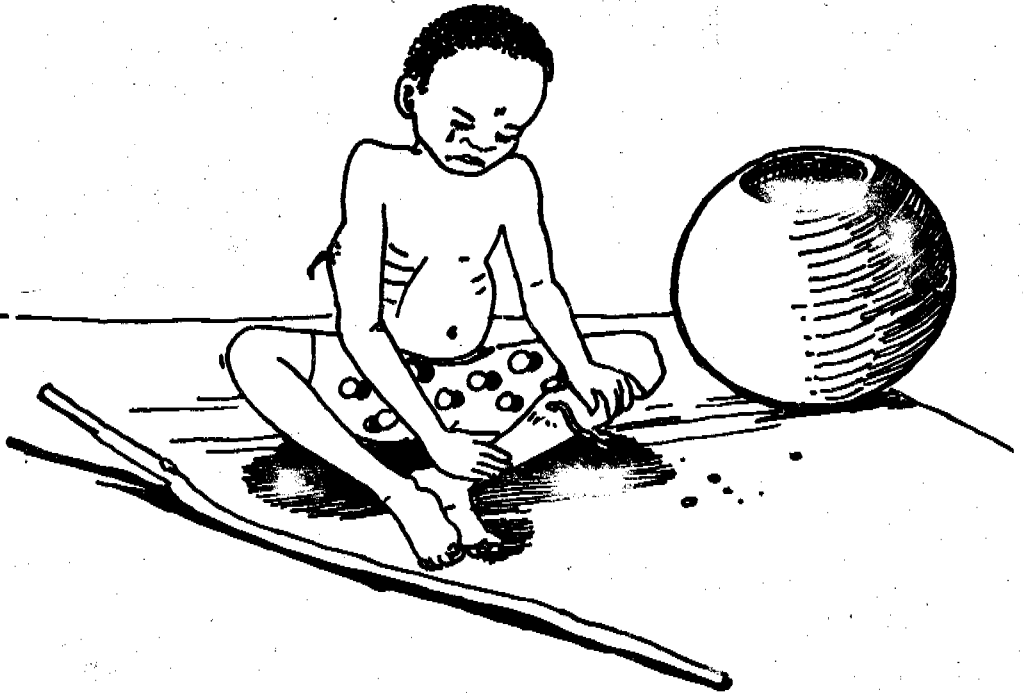

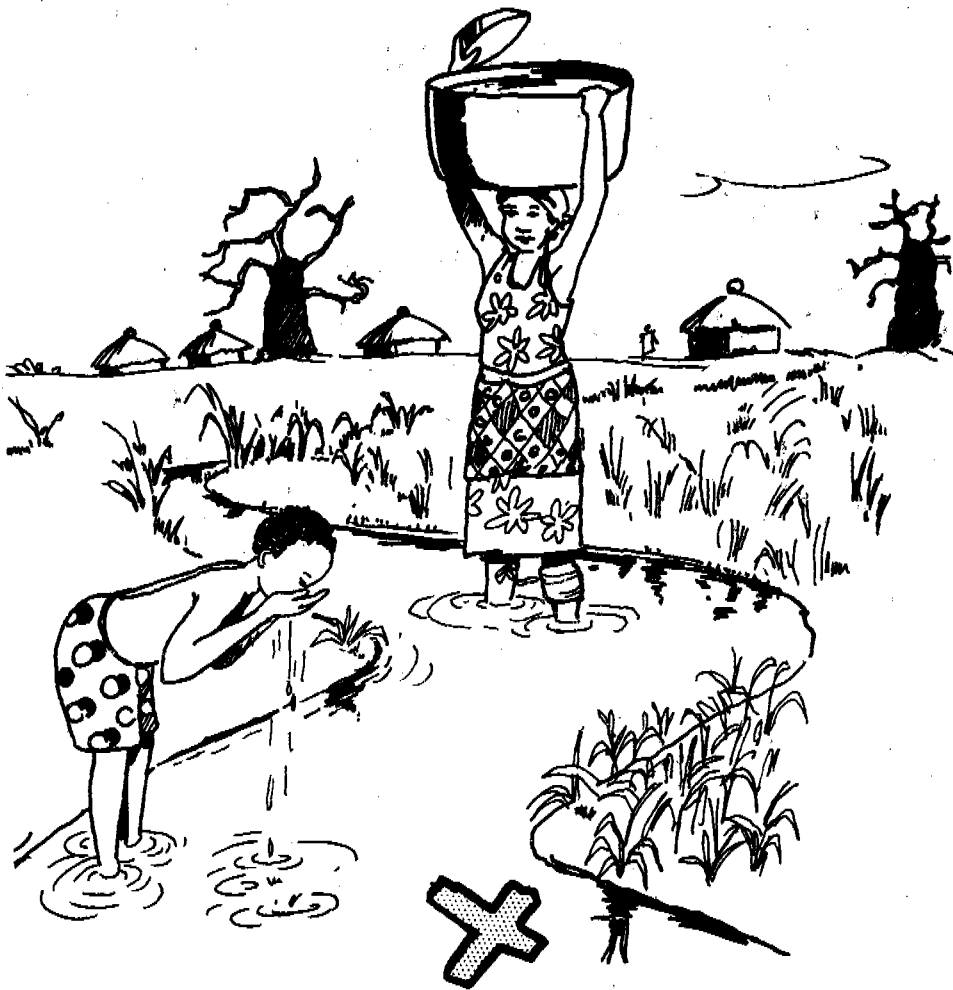

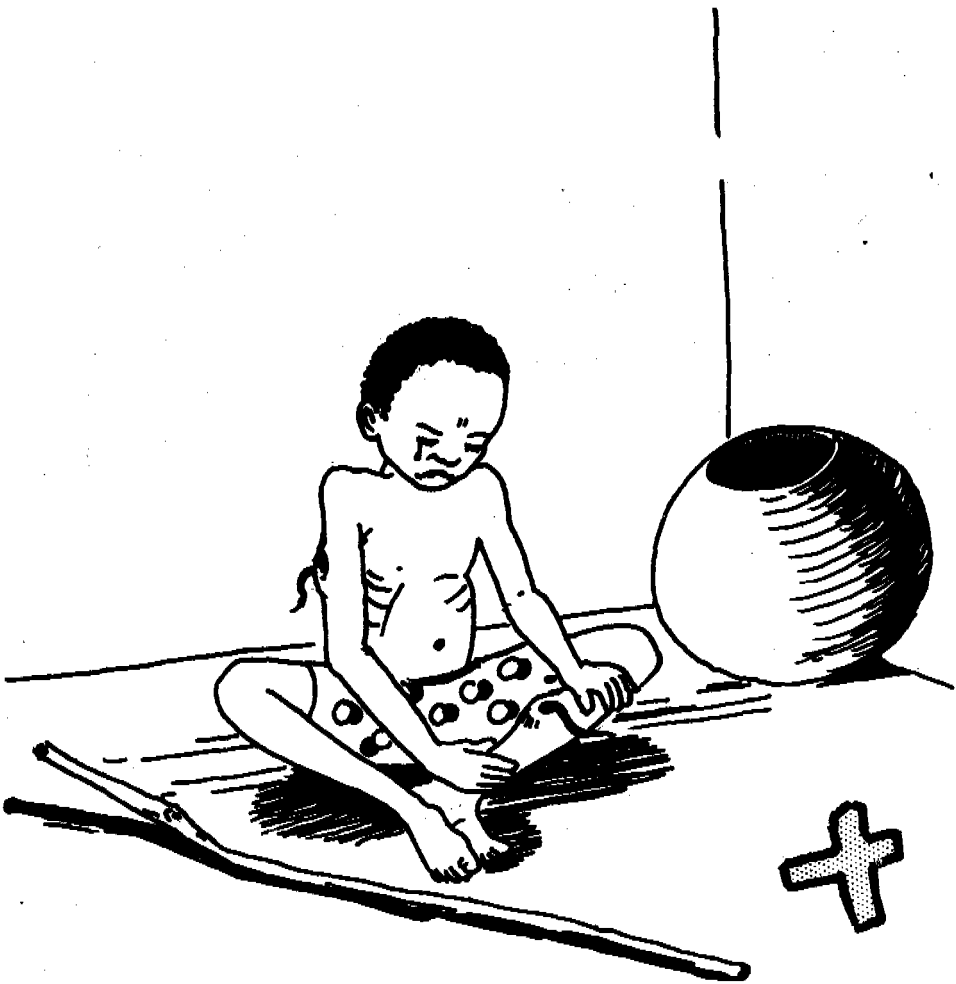

Water from an open source should not be drunk directly



Prevent this by not drinking directly from
guinea worm infested water



You can send someone to fetch water for you
if you have guinea worm



Filter drinking Water

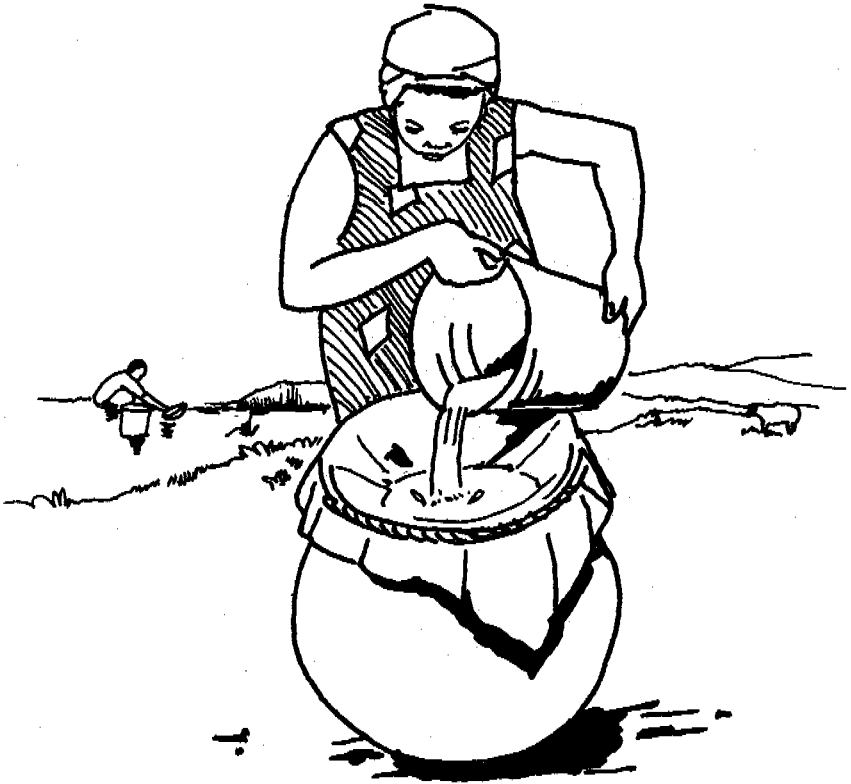
HOW TO FILTER WATER



Take a clean piece of cloth



Cover the mouth of the pot with the cloth and tie with a rope




Pour water from the river into the pot through the cloth



Your filtered water is now safe for drinking



Wash the cloth and hang it out to dry
